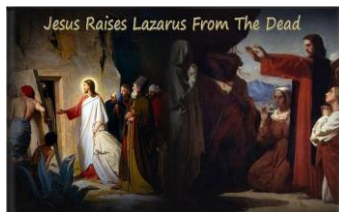
THOUGHT OF THE WEEK.....

This week the children have been thinking about having faith in God and how He comforts us at sad times in our lives.

Martha and Mary, Jesus' friends, were disappointed that Jesus had not arrived to see their brother, Lazarus, before he had died. They said they believed in the resurrection on the final day, but had not yet seen God's power to raise the dead.

They believed in His power to heal and that He was the Messiah. But Jesus wanted to increase their faith; He wanted them to see the full power and glory of God, to give substance to His promises.

Jesus knew that it was the will of God that Lazarus would die and that his resurrection would show God's glory. He did not raise Lazarus to make his friends happy. He raised Lazarus to show the glory of God.



Jesus said, 'I am the resurrection and the life. He who believes in me will live, even though he dies' " (John 11:25).
