### ST TERESA

St Teresa was born in 1873 and died at the young age of 24. Teresa was one of five children, brought up by her father after her mother's death when Teresa was only four years old. When she was just 14, Teresa decided she wanted to dedicate her life to God and became a nun. She never stopped being cheerful despite suffering from tuberculosis and made sure that every minute of her life was used for caring for others. Her best known saying was, "What matters in life is not great deeds but great love."

Teresa was made a Saint in 1925 and is one of St Matthew's School 'House Saints.'
